## How to Play:

#### Game Set Up:

- Print and laminate the game board
- Print and laminate the cards and cut out (you may want to print two sets so you have plenty of cards)
- Shuffle cards and place face down

#### Rules of Play:

- First player draws a card from the pile. They must then count to find the total. They then either move ahead or move backward according to the directions on the card to the appropriate numeral space.
- Players then take turns drawing a card and counting to move ahead or backward. The first player to land on the finish space wins.

Tip: As you play, stress that the pictures model the numbers II-20 as IO plus a number. For example, when your child counts twelve, say "Yes, twelve is ten and 2."
